GASOLINE ALLEY MUSEUM, HERITAGE TOWN SQUARE AND HISTORICAL VILLAGE:

Shops close 1 hour after the Museum closes

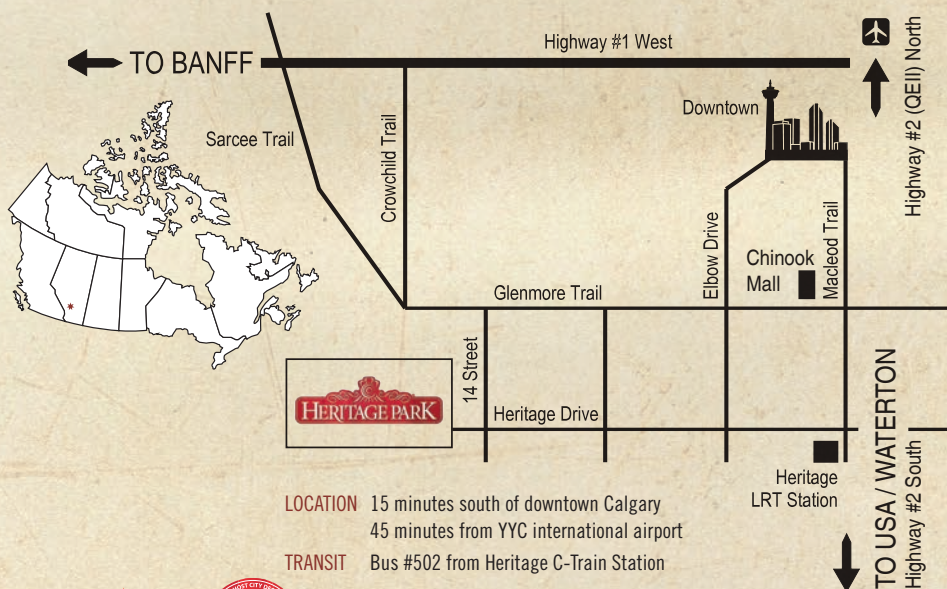
Access to Heritage Town Square with its unique shops and restaurants, as well as a 2-acre nature park is available all year round at no additional charge.
