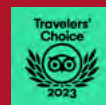


### Gasoline Alley Museum 1930s to 1950s

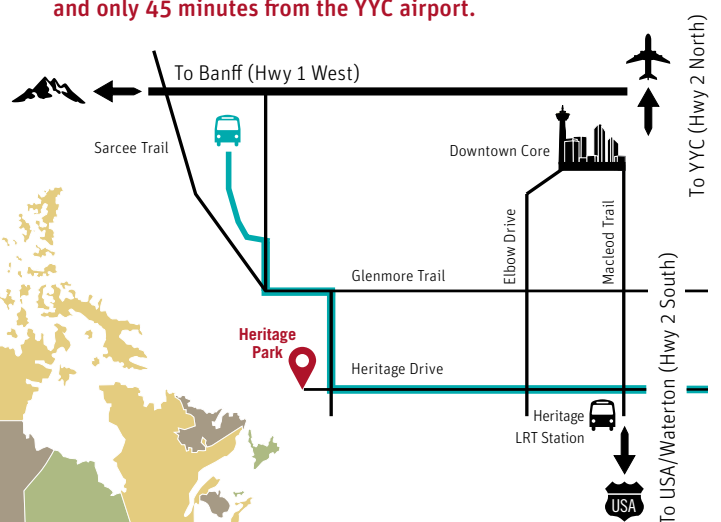
