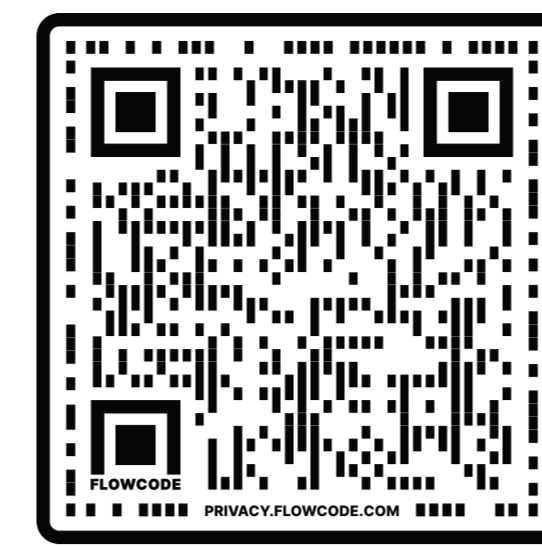
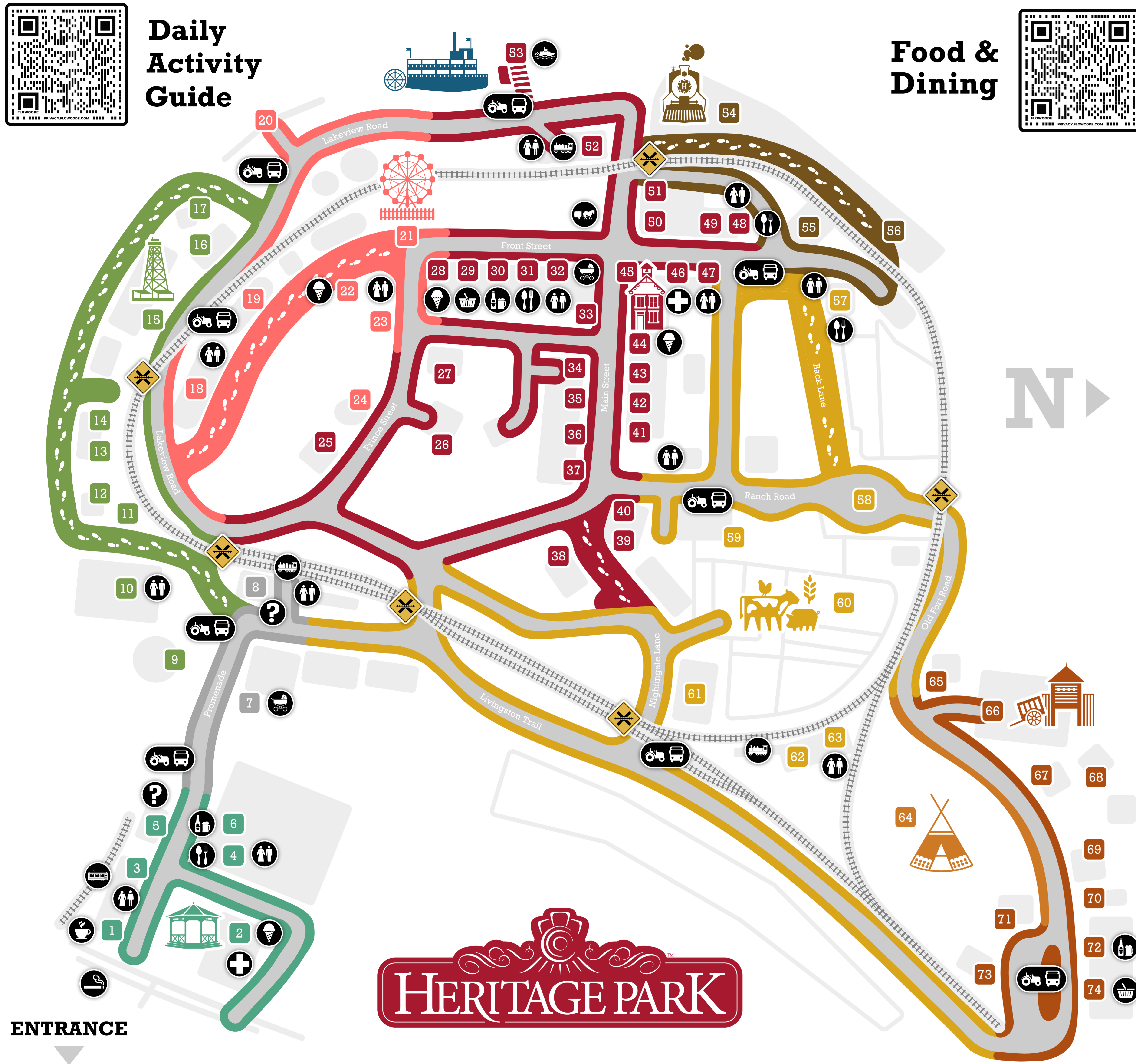

**Heritage Plaza**

Explore Gasoline Alley Museum, showcasing antique vehicles and oil & gas artifacts. Nearby, the Haskayne Mercantile Block offers family-friendly dining options and boasts five distinctive stores with local treasures, kitchenware, Indigenous products, toys and so much more!

**Resource Ridge**

Learn about Alberta's energy and resource story with hand-on activities. Start with a visit to Innovation Crossing, then try your hand at panning for gold at the Prospector's Tent. Delve into the dark of a coal mine before making your way along the scenic path to the Warden's Cabin.

**Antique Midway**

Feel the wind in your hair as you spin on the Whip, ride the Dangler swings or take flight on the Ferris Wheel. Don't forget to visit the Midway Treatery for some old fashioned treats and snacks!

**Village Square**

Rewind the past 115 years as you stroll through the townscape that is the Village Square. Explore family homes, a newspaper office, Snooker Hall, Mounted Police Post and the Wainwright Hotel. Plus, don't miss the Alberta Bakery and the candy store for a sweet treat.

**Heritage Rail Yard**

Browse one of North America's largest pre-WW1 train collections. See how people travelled across the continent in the late 1800s and early 1900s and explore the Colonist Car, the Mount Resplendent, a Turntable, the Roundhouse, Grain Elevator and Construction Car #76.

**Ranch & Farm Life**

Cross over into the agriculture area and learn about resilient farmers and enterprising ranchers. Get a glimpse of the goats, shoot the breeze with the sheep, chatter with the chickens or have a parley with the pigs.

**First Nations Encampment**

Deepen your understanding of local Indigenous cultures through stories from our experienced interpreters and traditional knowledge-keepers. Participate in unique activities while you reflect, learn and observe with us.

**The Settlement**

Explore southern Alberta's roots and discover pre-1883 buildings—many of which reflect the shared history of Métis people from this region. Learn about this turbulent time period as our interpreters share skills, traditions and stories.
